

## **The John Vosler Scholarship Award for the Pursuit of Musical Education**

Dr. John A. Vosler was an area physician whose love of medicine was matched only by his love of music. He played a cornet most of his life, and was often involved in several bands at one time, all the way up to age 84, when he was sadly forced to stop due to the tragic consequences of Alzheimer's Disease. Until that time, he was an active member of the community, and an enthusiastic advocate for all things related to music, including its ability to provide value and meaning throughout a person's life.

Those who are interested in this scholarship will need to meet the following requirements:

- 1) Student must be a senior in high school, in good standing at the time of graduation
- 2) Student must have achieved a 3.0 GPA by the end of his or her senior year
- 3) Student must produce a recommendation from a musical authority, either a vocal or music teacher, or a band instructor, for example
- 4) Student must plan on attending college, technical school, or a musical conservatory following his or her high school graduation, *with the intent of studying music as a major part of their education*
- 5) Student may be asked to undergo an interview
- 6) Though it is not a requirement for consideration, expressing financial need for this scholarship will certainly be considered

Our goal as we seek to award this scholarship is to find a well-rounded student who possesses a strong desire to pursue the study of music upon leaving high school. We are looking for someone who sees music as their life goal, either directly or indirectly, and we will favor those who can show a true love for not only the study of music, but the value of music in their lives, both now and in the future.
