Graduation Requirements for Class of 2023

- ✿ English 4 credits
- ✿ Mathematics 4 credits (must include Algebra II)
- ✿ Science 3 credits (1 Physical Science, 1 Biology and 1 elective science)
- ✿ Social Studies 3 credits (1 credit of Modern World History, 1 credit of American History, 1 credit of US Government)
- ✿ Technology 1 credit
- ✿ English Elective ½ credit
- ✿ Health ½ credit
- ✿ Physical Education ½ credit
- ✿ Fine Arts 1 credit (can be earned 7th-12th)
- ✿ Electives 6.5 credits (business, technology, fine arts or foreign language)
- ✿ Earn 24 Credits by Graduation Date in May/June of 2023
- ✿ Must take 7 End-of-Course exams -earn a total of 18 points
- ✿ To move onto sophomore status must earn 6 credits.

End of Course Exams

- ✿ English 9
- ✿ English 10
- ✿ Algebra 1
- ✿ Geometry
- ✿ Biology
- ✿ American History
- ✿ American Government
- ✿ 4 points earned between combined English tests
- ✿ 4 points earned between combined Math tests
- ✿ 6 points earned within the science and social studies tests.
- ✿ A minimum total of 18 points earned from all tests

CREDITS

To move on to the next grade you must earn credits by passing your classes.

- 6 credits = Sophomore
 - 12 credits = Junior
 - 18 credits = Senior
 - 24 credits = Graduate
